## Claire's Corner

Term 4 classes started with much excitement about the Jamboree pieces. Many classes are working with scripts, some are adapting scripts from texts, and some are playbuilding from a given stimulus.

The Musical Theatre groups are rehearsing numbers, coordinating vocals with choreography. The dance classes are getting the rhythm as they tap their toes and shimmy to the beat.

Student Safety: As we all know, the traffic jam outside HSPA each Saturday can be manic. Just a reminder that YPT policy for student drop off is that parents take care and observe the traffic rules. For pickup after class at HSPA, tutors will keep the children on the fence side of the footpath and wait for parents to collect their child in person. If parents sit in their cars and beckon a child to cross the road or walk substantially away from the gate, the tutor will instruct the child to stay with them. For rehearsals at HSPA, the directors will also maintain supervision of students at pickup time. It is important that parents consider that NCC rangers may be in attendance. Please also be aware that, should parents not pick up students on time, a Late Student Pickup Fee may apply.

## **YPT Policies**

Theatre School Attendance Policy: to maintain a place in class, students must maintain 75% attendance and appropriate participation in classes

Theatre Company Audition Policy: to be eligible to audition for productions, students must maintain 75% attendance and appropriate participation in classes; 75% attendance & an appropriate behaviour/participation in previous rehearsals /performances;

parent and student attend the PIM; student submits a parent signed Production Commitment Form; plus any production specific criteria

YPT Dress Code: students wear a YPT logo black T-shirt to classes, auditions & designated performances

Theatre School Refund Policy: unless special circumstances are demonstrated, a fees refund is not available after the first three classes

Associate Student Membership Policy: Year 12 students may apply for Associate Membership.

Photography Policy: taking photos or filming students engaged in YPT activities is not permitted

Working with Children legislation: YPT employees (above the age of 18 years) and all volunteers are required to submit a Working with Children Clearance (WWCC) before engaging in YPT activities.


