Payment of Invoices, Semester 2

YPT has a new Student Management System; we will no longer be posting the coloured Enrolment Forms.

Semester 2 invoicing will be via email with all family members and courses in which that are enrolled, appearing on the same invoice.

There will be 2 options for Payment of the Semester 2 invoices:

- 1. by clicking on the 'pay now' link in the invoice email by Visa or Master card (no charges)
- 2. bank transfer

YPT will no longer accept cash payments for fees. For YPT, these new processes significantly reduce the burden on our administration and volunteer team. There are also environmental benefits through the reduction of paper, envelopes and postage. Most importantly the new process is faster and more efficient for our families.

Creative Kids and Active Kids Vouchers

If you missed submitting your voucher for Semester 1, Semester 2 voucher details can be submitted to YPT by **15 May.** To have you voucher processed by YPT:

- 1. Go to the YPT Website https://ypt.org.au/theatreschool/
- 2. Click on the Theatre School page
- 3. Follow the instructions on this page relating to AK + CK. This includes completing a Google form with your voucher details.
- 4. Your redemption will be applied to your Semester 2 Invoice that will be emailed on 7 June.

YPT Attendance Policy

We are often asked questions about the Attendance Policy. Student attendance may impact offers of enrolment in the following semester as well as eligibility to audition for productions. While the policy can be found in the Terms and Conditions section of our website, in this addition of Spotlight, we are featuring this important policy:

Policy: Theatre School Attendance

To retain a place in the Theatre School in the following semester appropriate participation, behaviour and a 75% attendance rate over the previous twelve months (or pro rata for a shorter period of enrolment) is required.

Applications for Leave of Absence may be emailed to **ypt@ypt.org.au** for leave **greater than 2 weeks** duration for family holidays or ongoing illness. Approved leaves of absence are excluded from the 75% attendance policy.

Leave of Absence will not be approved for sport, other weekly commitments personal or school commitments, short holidays (less than 2 weeks), participation in productions with other theatre companies; or events with schools or other organisations. Leave of absence will not be approved for one-off sick leave absences.

YPT Production Audition Eligibility Policy

Students are eligible to audition for productions based on:

- punctuality, appropriate behaviour and participation in Drama and extension classes
- 75% attendance in Theatre School Drama classes;
- production specific requirements, ie. age appropriateness for the role, ability to sing the role, etc
- continued attendance at Drama classes during the rehearsal phase and performance season
- appropriate record of attendance and behaviour in previous productions
- parent volunteer support in previous productions
- parent provision to the Office of a current Working With Children Check prior to the audition
- student and parent attendance at a Production Information Meeting (PIM)
- lodgement of a parent signed Production Commitment Form at the audition
